Fishing Rules and Regulations

- By Walpole Island First Nation fishing permit only
- Bass season July 2 to Nov. 30, 2022
- Muskellunge season June 4 to Dec. 15, 2022
- Other species like panfish [sunfish, pumpkin seeds, bluegill, crappie, perch, rockbass] July 2, to Sept 14, 2022
- Fishing is closed one week prior to hunting season, only open outside waterways during this time [Sept. 14, 2022]
- Springtime spawning beds will be monitored [SHADES IN RED]
WILL OPEN UP July 2, to Sept 14, 2022

Hunting Rules and Regulations:

- By Walpole Island First Nation permit only with WIFN guide
- Guide must be a Walpole Island band member and 16 years of age or older
- Season begins third Saturday in September
- Will be strictly enforced
- Sunday hunting allowed
- Duck resting areas will be monitored
- Sanctuaries will be monitored

PROHIBITED AREAS:

- Spawning Grounds
- No jet skis in all inland waterways
- No access in posted prohibited areas
